1. What is meant by SNTD University?

Ans. SNTD stands for "Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Women's University". It has its headquarters at Mumbai. It has a semester pattern and a grading system.

2. Is this a distance learning course?

Ans. No, The SNTD Women's University is the only University which can have affiliated colleges all over India. This special provision was made under MU Act 1965. Regular classes and exams are conducted here at our college campus.

3. Where is this college situated?

Ans. 3rd Floor, Shradha House, 345, Kingsway, Nagpur.

4. What kind of further education we can go for after BCA & B.Sc(IT)?

5. Which courses are offered by your college?

Ans. Any stream (Arts, commerce & science) with 40% marks in 12th. Non maths students are also eligible. Polytechnic and MCVC students are also eligible.

8. What the eligibility for B.Sc(IT)?

Ans. 12th Science and maths with 45%. Polytechnic and MCVC students are also eligible.

9. Do you have qualified and experienced faculty?

Ans. Yes, there are sufficient number of Full-time Faculty members which are well-qualified and highly experienced.

10. What facilities do we have at campus level?

Ans: Computer Labs, Wi-fi, Library, water-coolers, ventilated Class-rooms, Canteen.

21. What is the marks distribution criteria in your university?

Ans: For a theory subject the distribution is 75 marks on paper and 25 marks internals.

For a practical subject the distribution is 50 marks on paper and 50 marks practicals.

Ans: This college is working since 10 Years.

23. Is college uniform compulsory?

Ans: Yes, College uniform is compulsory.

24. What is the procedure for applying for Bonafide Certificate?

Ans. The student has to apply for the Bonafide Certificate which will be issued in two working days.

Technical workshops and seminar on latest technologies are conducted.

28. Is there any facility for sports?

Ans. Yes, there is a well-equipped Sports Room within Campus. The students are encouraged to participate in Intercollegiate Sports Meet.
